Subcontractor Minimum Insurance Requirements

The Subcontractor shall purchase from and maintain from a company or companies lawfully authorized to do business with Bobbitt such insurance as will protect the Subcontractor from claims which may arise out of or as a result of the Subcontractor's operations under this Agreement, whether such operations be by the Subcontractor or by a sub-subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them, or by anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, with the following minimum limits:

Subcontract will not be considered until evidence of insurance satisfactory to Bobbitt is on file with Bobbitt. Award of subcontract and payment will not be authorized without a valid certificate of insurance indicating the above minimum limits of coverage are in effect during the time period required to complete the work covered under this agreement.
